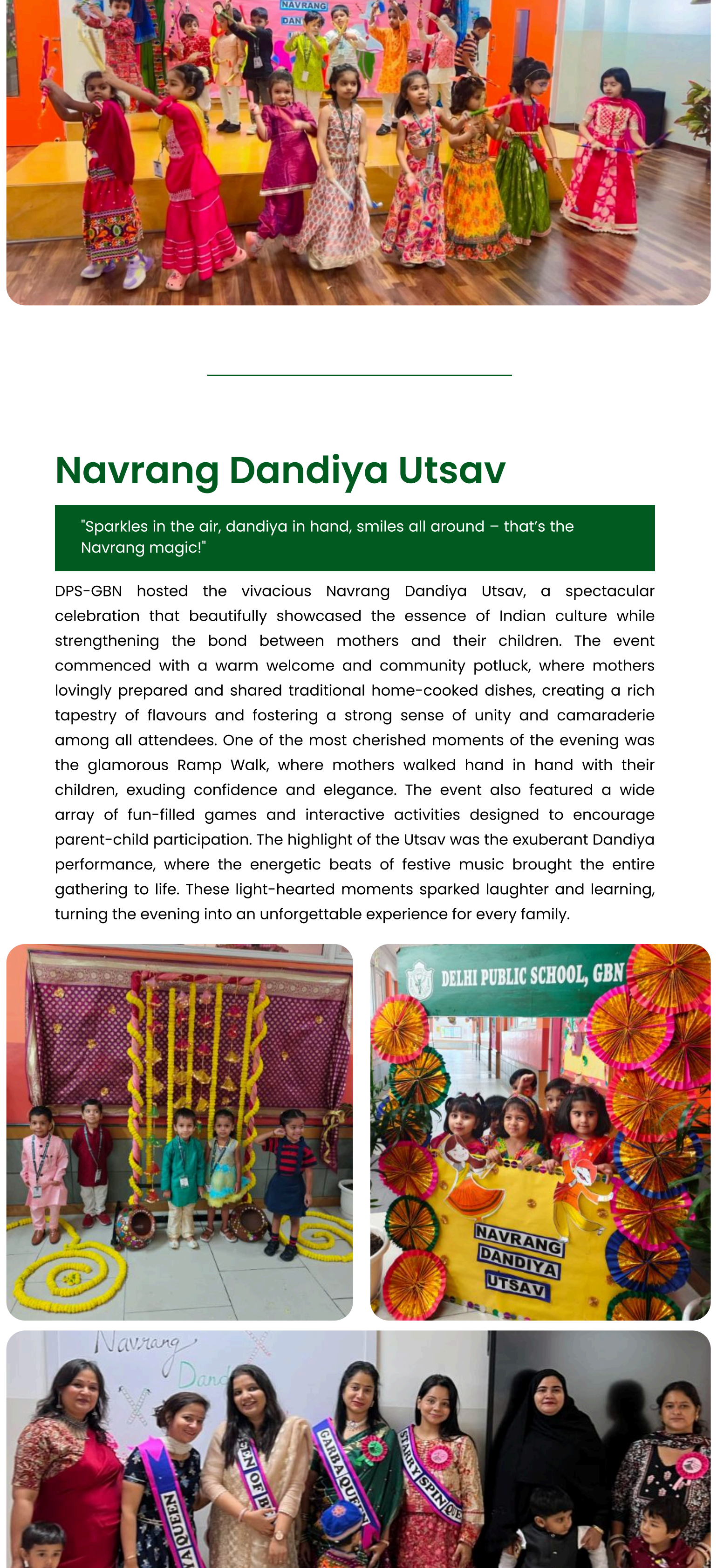


Garba Groove
