

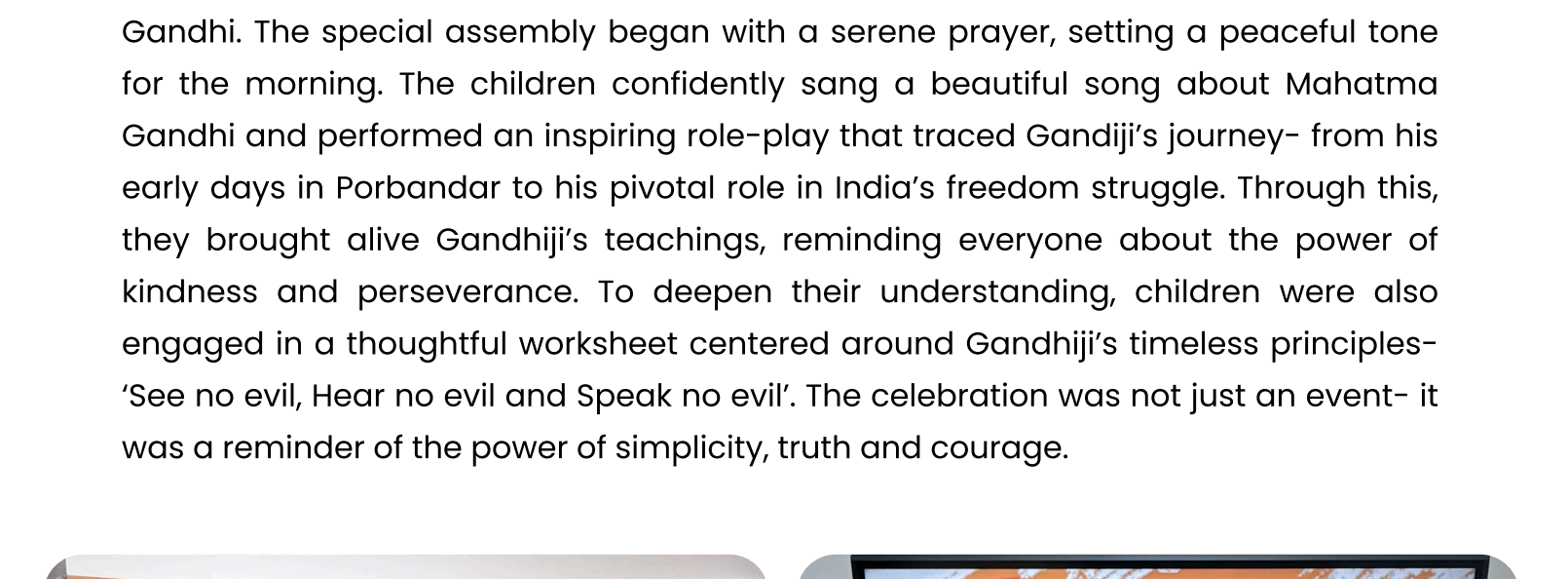
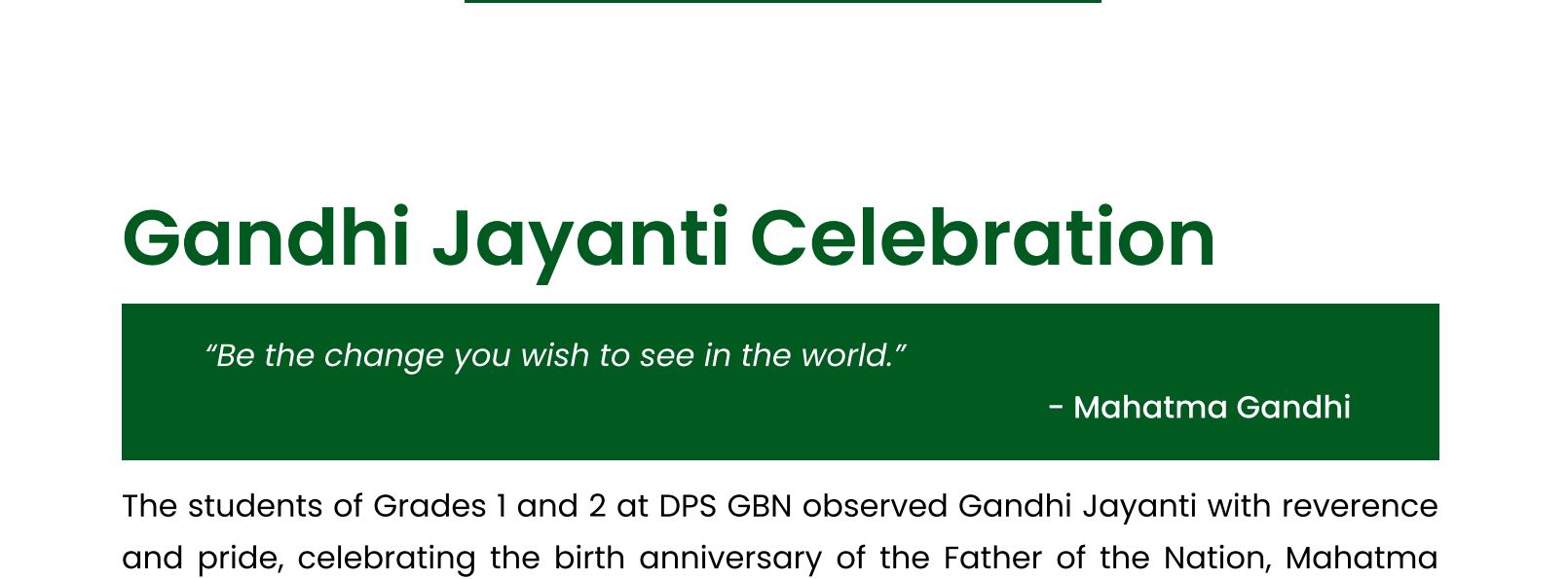


Dussehra Celebration

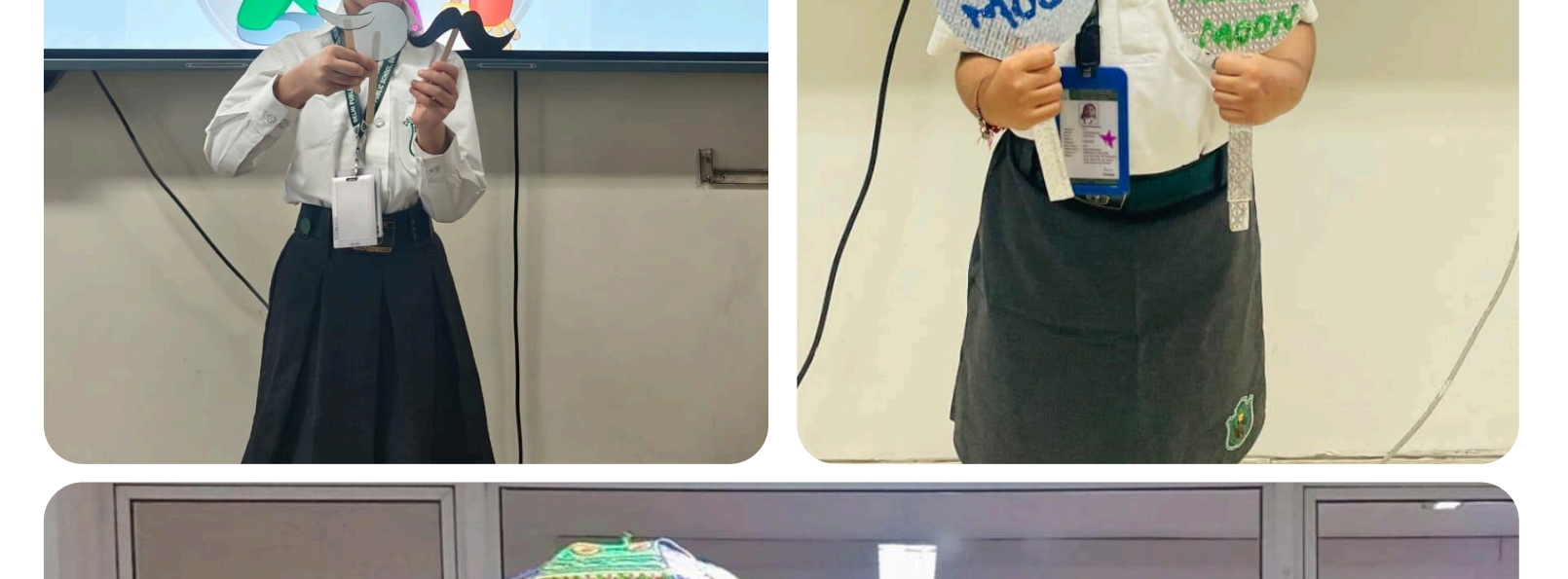
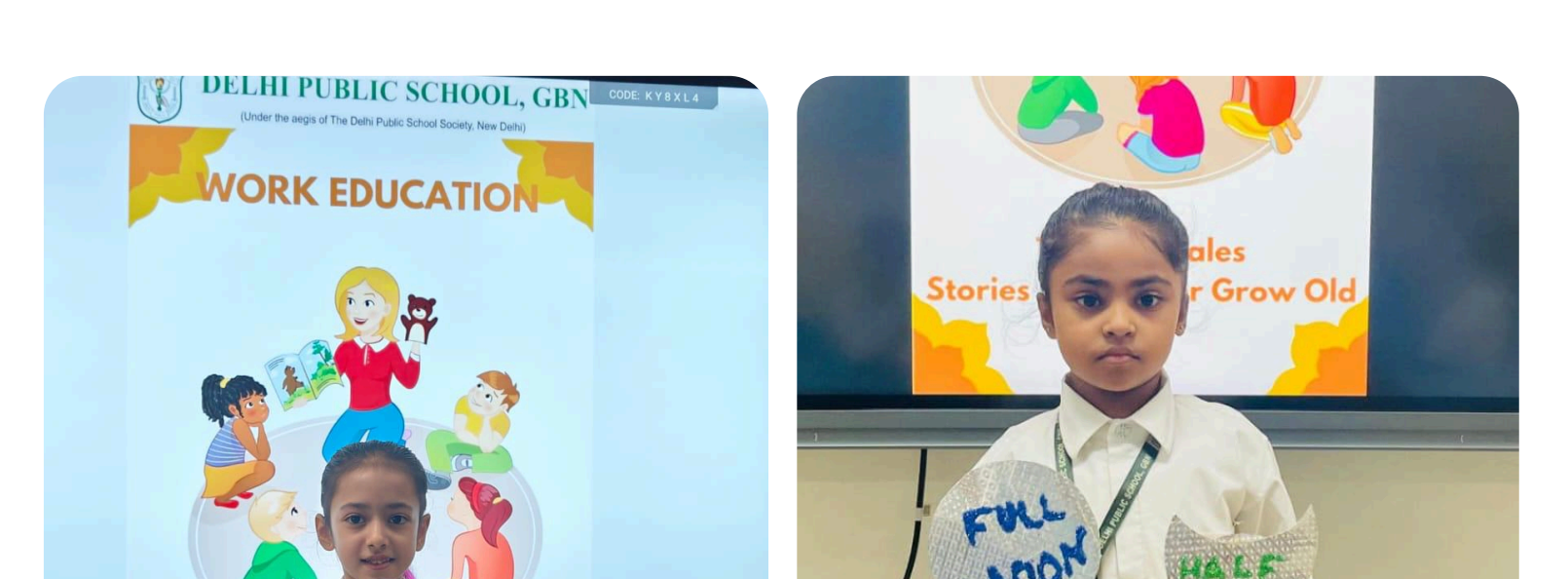
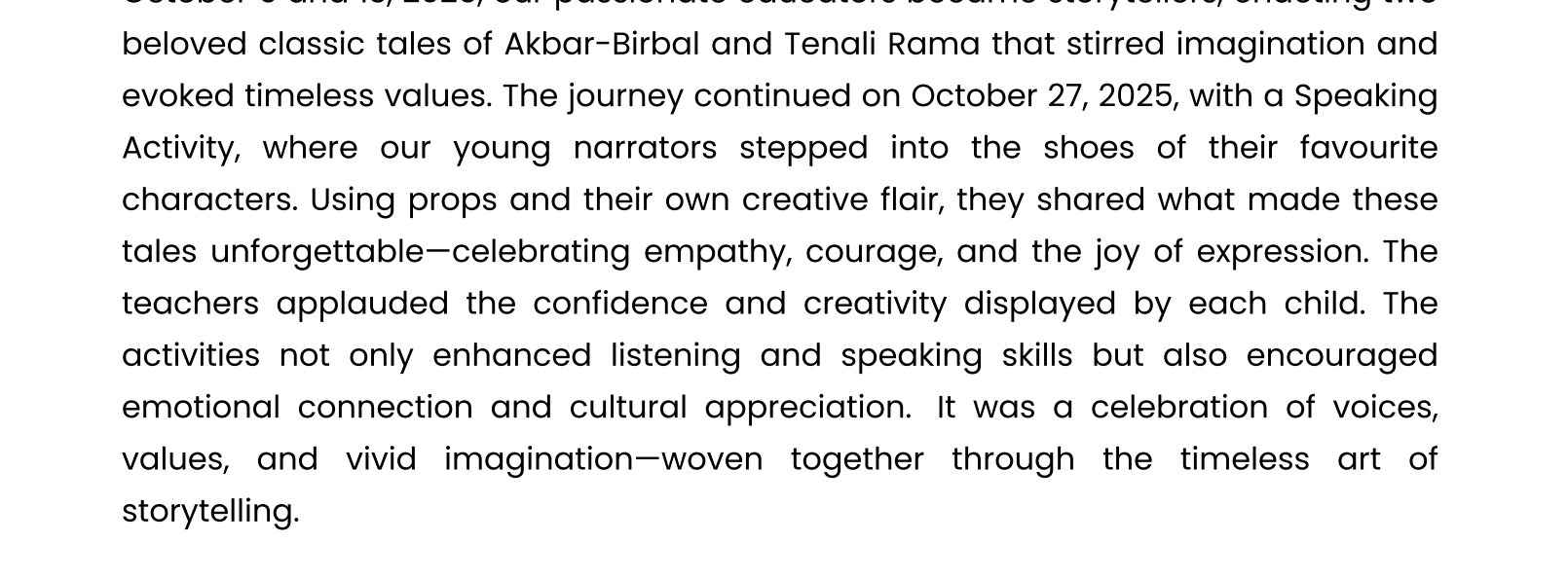


Gandhi Jayanti Celebration

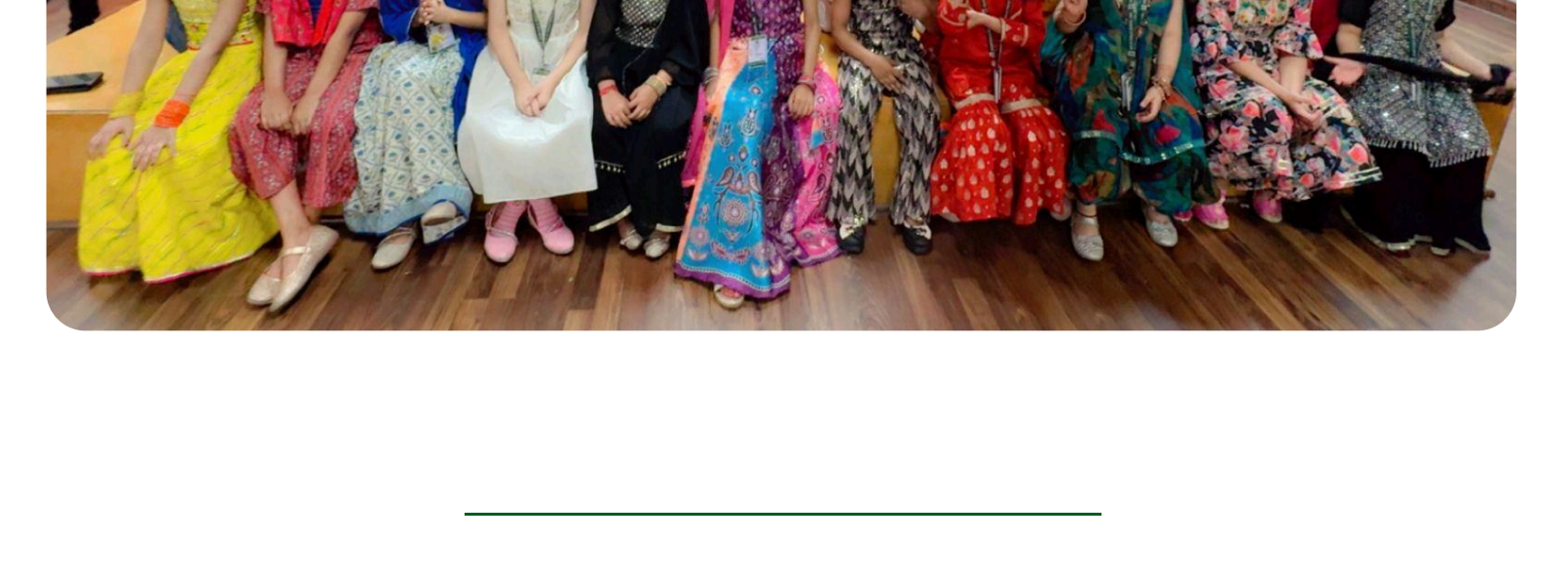


Work Education- Timeless Tales

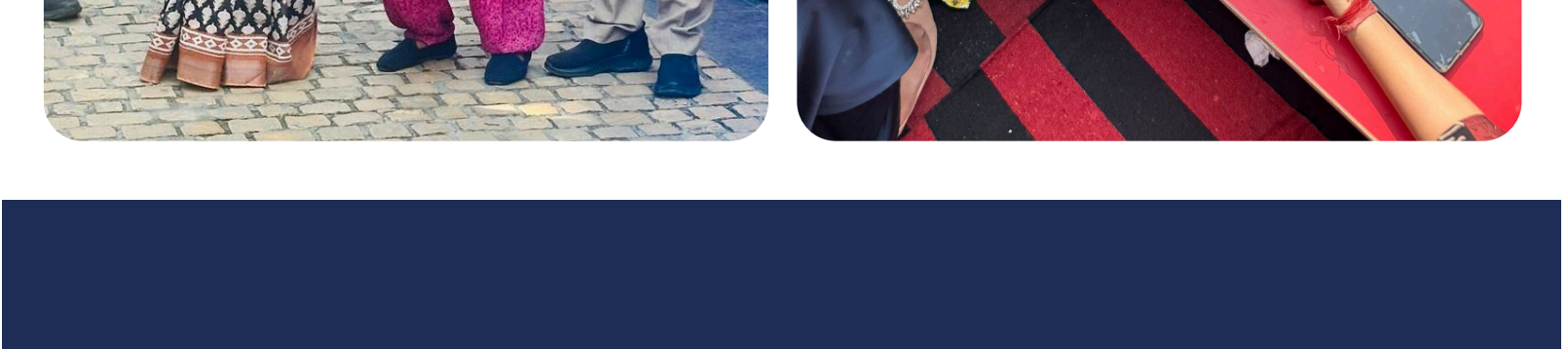


Celebrating the Festival of Lights, Joy, and Creativity
